BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct four (4) yard tracks at grade across Mt. Vernon Avenue in the County of San Bernardino at the locations described in the application as Tracks Nos. 1 to 4, inclusive, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-539.8. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72 without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rail flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
