BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the County of Orange for an order authorizing the construction and maintenance of a road crossing over the right of way and tracks of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY at Baker Avenue in Orange County, California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The County of Orange is authorized to construct Baker Avenue at grade across the spur tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6N-40.71-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement between Pacific Electric Railway Company and the applicant, to be filed with the Commission. Width of the crossing shall be not less than thirty (30) feet and grades of approach not greater than two (2) per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B.).

Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
