BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to construct various interchange tracks at grade across Charter Way and Clay, Jackson, Jefferson, Anderson, and Worth Streets in Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application. Charter Way is in a subway at the point of crossing and the remaining streets are not open or traveled at the respective points of crossing. This order shall not be deemed as authorizing the opening of said streets across said tracks. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
