SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

San Bernardino Valley Transit Company on August 30, 1943, filed its Thirteenth Supplemental Application in this proceeding requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a motor coach service to provide passenger transportation for the Mountain View Trailer Camp, which houses Army Air Depot workers exclusively. Applicant now has operative rights between Colton and the Army Air Depot, via San Bernardino, together with another line known as the Shandin Hills-Army Air Depot Line.

Applicant proposes to establish a motor coach service from Third and "E" Streets in the City of San Bernardino to be operated by way of the Mountain View Trailer Camp to the Army Air Depot in order to furnish workers now residing in this development with transportation to both the City of San Bernardino and the Army Air Depot. The service proposed to be provided is of an on-call character to be rendered at such intervals between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 12:00 midnight as is necessary to furnish transportation for Army Air Depot workers and their families. Other local transportation facilities in the City of San Bernardino are so routed that no service is provided to this area. The rate to be charged by applicant for this service is 6¢ per passenger per trip, with provision to issue commutation books in accordance with the terms of Tariff C.R.C. No. 3 now in effect.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, that there is a need for the service proposed, and that the application should be granted.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to San Bernardino Valley Transit Company for the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 27 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers between Third and "E" Streets in the City of San Bernardino, and the Army Air Depot, via Mountain View Trailer Camp, as an extension and enlargement of applicant's operative rights, subject to the following condition:

- (1) San Bernardino Valley Transit Company, its successors or assigns, may never claim before this Commission or any court or other public body, a value, for any purpose, for the certificate herein granted in excess of the actual cost incurred by it in securing said operative rights.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the operation of passenger stage service, pursuant to the foregoing certificate, the following service regulations shall be complied with:

- (1) Applicant shall file written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
- (2) Applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 79 by filing, in triplicate, and making effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.
- (3) Subject to the authority of the Commission to change or modify it at any time by further order, applicant shall conduct said passenger stage service over the following route:

Commencing at Third and "E" Streets in the City of San Bernardino; thence east along Third Street to Arrowhead Avenue; thence south along Arrowhead Avenue to Cluster Street; thence east along Cluster Street to Sierra Way; thence north along Sierra Way to Rialto Avenue; thence east along Rialto Avenue to Waterman Avenue; thence north along Waterman Avenue to Third Street; and thence over already certificated route to the Army Air Depot.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
