

Decision No. 36668

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of the People of the State of California, acting by and through the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of crossings at grade of the East Broadway Extension) Application and the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway in and in the vicinity of Hawthorne, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

ORIGINAL

The People of the State of California, acting by and through the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct an extension of East Broadway across two spur tracks off the El Segundo Branch of Pacific Electric Railway Company, in and in the vicinity of Hawthorne, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RA-12.90-C, in the County of Los Angeles, and Crossing No. 6RA-13.54-C, in the City of Hawthorne.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than 44 feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each location (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
