ORDER

ORIGINAL

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across a public road in the City of Vernon, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-144.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rail flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 6 per cent, Protection shall be by one Standard No. 3 wigwag and one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
