BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for an order approving the widening of Bridge aA-5 and the maintenance of a 12-foot clearance therein in connection with the construction of second main track and a passing track between Colton and Highgrove, San Bernardino County, California.

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to widen Bridge aA-5 over La Cadena Drive, in the County of San Bernardino, more particularly described by the map attached to the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing #2B-4.1-B, and maintain the new construction at a 12-foot overhead clearance, to correspond to the portion of the structure already in use. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne by applicant.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
