O P I N I O N

Southern Counties Gas Company of California seeks authority to exer-
cise a franchise granted by the City of Newport Beach, permitting the main-
tenance of gas facilities upon the streets of said City.

As the franchise referred to is one granted by the City in accordance
with the Franchise Act of 1937, it is provided therein that it shall be of
indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the City equivalent to
2 per cent of the gross receipts arising from the use of the franchise, but
not less than 1 per cent for all sales of gas by applicant within the City.
The direct costs to applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have
been \$65.78.

According to the record, Mr. Le Roy M. Edwards, witness for the
Applicant, stated that the present certificate, granted by this Commission to
exercise the rights and privileges of the old franchise, would be surrendered
by the Company upon granting of the certificate herein requested.

As this utility has for many years served gas within and about the
City of Newport Beach without competition, it is evident that its request for
a certificate to exercise its franchise should be granted.

O R D E R

A public hearing having been held upon the application of Southern Counties Gas Company of California, the matter considered, and it appearing to the Commission and it being found as a fact that public convenience and necessity so require, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company of California, be and hereby is granted a certificate to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Newport Beach by Ordinance No. 524, adopted August 2, 1943, subject to the condition, however, that no claim of value for such franchise or the authority herein granted in excess of the actual cost thereof shall ever be made by grantee, its successors, or assigns, before this Commission or before any court or other public body.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
