BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

State Park Commission, State of California, is authorized to construct a pedestrian underpass at separated grades under the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company near San Clemente, Orange County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-206.3-BD. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, (unless time be extended) or if conditions are not complied with.

This order shall be effective immediately.
