BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has applied for authority to sell a parcel of operative property in the City of Long Beach to Lloyd S. Whaley for the sum of \$1,000.00, and to remove the end of a spur track now located on said property.

It appears that neither the track nor the property are required in the performance of any service to the public, and that the parcel of property lies within an area which is proposed to be used in the construction of approximately 500 homes for the United States Navy civilian workers at Roosevelt Base Dry Dock. The application should be granted subject to certain conditions.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to sell that certain parcel of property described in the application and shown on the map accompanying the application for the sum of \$1,000.00 subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall within thirty days thereafter notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant is authorized to remove approximately 1,480 feet of track at the end of its so-called Daisy Avenue spur, now located on the property to be transferred, and including the crossing with Wardlow Road identified as Crossing

No. 6LA-16.43. Within thirty days thereafter applicant shall report in writing to the Commission the removal of said spur track.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authorization herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
