ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By petition filed April 30, 1942, in these proceedings, four highway and city carriers¹ specializing in the transportation of property from or to motion picture studios and location sites sought modification of the minimum rates established for that transportation (Decision No. 33226, dated June 18, 1940). Thereafter, petitioners were instructed to advise the Commission when they would be prepared to offer evidence in support of their proposals. More than a year has passed without further word from petitioners. During this time, substantial changes in transportation conditions have occurred. Under the circumstances, the petition will be dismissed.
