ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to remove two Standard No. 4 wigwags at each of the two following crossings on its Del Rey-Redondo Line in the City of Culver City - Washington Boulevard (Crossing No. 6F-9.52), and Duquesne Avenue (Crossing No. 6F-9.65), subject to the provision that, concurrently with the removal of said wigwags, the paving in of the track areas, shown in red on map attached to the application, shall be commenced and that said work shall be completed without undue delay.

Within thirty days after the completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
