OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, City Wharf & Warehouse Co., operating as a public utility wharfinger at Eureka, seeks authority to lease designated portions of its facilities to Albers Milling Company and L. E. Branchflower. The balance of these facilities, applicant's verified statements disclose, is ample to meet all present and prospective demands for public utility service. Moreover, the revenue to be derived from the proposed leases is said to be essential to continued public utility operations.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Wharf & Warehouse Co., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to lease to Albers Milling Company and L. E. Branchflower those portions of its facilities designated in the proposed leases attached to the application
