IT IS HEREBY ORDERLD that that portion of First Supplemental Application No. 23775 requesting permission to modify its Route No. 1, between the intersection of Pacific Avenue and Goodwin Road and the intersection of Brunswick Street and Los Feliz Boulevard, by operating over Goodwin Road and Brunswick Street is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Decision No. 35264 is affirmed and in full force and effect.
