## FIRST SUPRLEISNIL OPINION AND ORDER

This proceedine involves rates for the transportation Of fuel oil in buik in tant truck esuipment from Zonterey to San Juan. By Decision No. 36109 in this proceocing, applicant was authorized to perform this transportation service for Tide تiater Associated 011 Company at a rate rot less than 4 3/4 cents per 100 pounds. The minimum rate otherwise appifcable, proscribed by Decision No. 32608, as amenced, in Case No. 4246 in re Bates of dil Common and Hishmay Carriers. is 5 zents per 100 pounds. Applicant's authority to observe iorer rates will expire January 19, 1944. By supplemental application its extension for a oneyear period is sought.

Applicant's verified statements disciose that it still enjoys unusually favorable conditions in connection with the handing of this trafinc and that the subnormal costs experienced under these exceptional condivions permit satisfactory operations to be maintained at a lorer ratc than the'minimum rate othorrise applicable.

It appears that this is a matter in which a puiblic hearing is not necossary and that the proposed extension of applicontis authority is justificd. Tho supplemental application will bo granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration dato of the authority granted by Decision No.. 36109 of January 29, 1943, in tho above entitled proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to January 19, 194.5, unless sooner changed, canceled or further oxtended by appropriate order of tine commission.
