
O R D E R

Holton Inter-Urban Railway Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Third Street in Holtville, Imperial County, at the location described in the application. Third Street is not traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across said spur tracks.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
