construct, maintain, and operate a passing
track at grade upon and across an unnamed
County Road at Knightsen in the County of
Contra Costa, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a passing track at grade across an unnamed county road near Knightsen, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-1142.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
