copy of each journal entry recorded on its books to
give effect to the sale, transfer and conveyance of
said properties."

Within one hundred and twenty (120) days after
the sale, transfer and conveyance of said properties
to Sacramento City Lines, Pacific Gas and Electric
Company shall file with the Railroad Commission a
true and correct copy of each journal entry recorded
on its books to give effect to the sale, transfer
and conveyance of said properties.
