FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The complete description of the No. 2, College-Main Street Line, as described on sheet 4 of the Order in Decision No. 36846, dated February 1, 1944, in the above-entitled application, does not in its entirety correctly describe said route, therefore

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the complete route of the No. 2, College-Main Street Line is hereby revised to read as follows:

Commencing at a loop, starting at Monterey and Pacific Avenues, bounded by Monterey Avenue, Kensington Way, Stadium Drive, and Pacific Avenue; thence on Pacific Avenue to Maple Street; thence on Maple Street to El Dorado Street; thence on El Dorado Street to Weber Avenue; thence on Weber Avenue to Ophir Street; thence on Ophir Street to East Main Street; thence on East Main Street to Garden Avenue; and perform tripper service continuing east on East Main Street to Anteros Street; north on Anteros Street to Horner Street; east on Horner Street to Sinclair Street; and returning via the same route.

In all other respects Decision No. 36846 shall remain in

full force and effect.
