## ORDER

The Department of Public Torks of the State of California is authorized to construct a state highway (III-Sut-Yub-3-Mvl-Y.C.) at separated grades over the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company at Marysville, Yuba County, at the location as shown by map, Exhibit A, attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-179.2-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative to said construction and maintenance, a copy of which shall be filed with the Commission prior to the commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will, after hearing, determine the division of cost. Plans of said crossing approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall be filed prior to commencement of construction. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G. O. 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years from the conclusion of the war or if conditions are not complied with.

This order shall be effective immediately.
