SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35209 of March 31, 1942, as amended, in this proceeding, conditions Nos. 2 and 7 of the order in Decision No. 30790 (41 C.R.C. 239) were suspended until May 1, 1944, in so far as these conditions required the maintenance of parity of fares between, and interchangeability of tickets at common fares of, applicant and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. Applicant requests that the suspension of these conditions be extended to May 1, 1945. It points out that the railway's fares were increased 10 per cent under authority granted by Decision No. 35007 (44 C.R.C. 26) and, it alleges, it does not desire to increase its fares to that level.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the conditions in question should be further suspended as requested.
