FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, Decision No. 36909, dated March 7, 1944, in the above case, ordered a certain schedule of rates, attached as Exhibit "A," and each of said tariff schedules containing the following language:


"A discount of 10.0% is to be applied and shown on each bill computed under this schedule of rates. \* \* \* \* \*"



Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that each of the schedules in Exhibit "A" of Decision No. 36909 be and it is hereby amended by striking therefrom the words "and shown" in the aforesaid clause.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that each customer bill computed under the rates set forth in Exhibit "A" shall contain the following language:

This bill has been computed in accordance with Railroad Commission Decision No. 36909 which ordered a reduction in the basic rates, plus a 10.0% discount therefrom.
