BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The County of Santa Barbara is authorized to construct a county road at grade across a spur track of Santa Maria Valley Railroad Company near Santa Maria, Santa Barbara County, at the location described in the application. Crossing No. will be assigned later. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Santa Maria Valley Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
