O R D E R

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, it is hereby ordered that the description of route in Section (1) of the Order in Decision No. 36970, dated April 4, 1944, be amended as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of Bridge Street and Shasta Street; thence northerly along Shasta Street to Center Street; westerly along Center Street to Plumas Street; northerly along Plumas to Forbes Avenue; westerly along Forbes Avenue to Cooper Avenue; southerly along Cooper Avenue to "B" Street; easterly along "B" Street to Plumas Street; thence northerly along Plumas Street to Bridge Street; thence easterly along Bridge Street to Feather River Bridge, all of which route is in the City of Yuba City; thence from the west end of Feather River Bridge; thence easterly along said bridge and 5th Street to "B" Street in the City of Marysville; thence via "B" Street to 18th Street and on 18th Street to the Junior College; returning to the Feather River Bridge via the same route with a loop at Cortez Square around "C" Street and 6th Street, all of this latter route being in the City of Marysville.

In all other respects Decision No. 36970 shall remain in full force and effect.
