O P I N I O N

Orville C. Head holds a certificate authorizing the transportation of passengers between Oxnard and Camarillo State Hospital, Ventura County, and intermediate points, as authorized by the Commission's Decision No. 35300, rendered April 28, 1942, on Application No. 24793. In the above entitled application Head requests the Commission to authorize him to abandon this operation and to revoke the certificate therefor.

In support of the authority sought applicant alleges in substance that practically all the passengers heretofore transported by him were employees of the State Hospital; that these employees have been successful in procuring sufficient gasoline to enable them to operate privately owned cars in sufficient numbers to completely serve all their traveling requirements between Oxnard and the State Hospital; that as a consequence thereof such employees have clubbed together and procured whatever transportation requirements they need between such points which has resulted in a diversion of all of applicant's traffic and patronage between said points and it is now impossible for him to continue to conduct his operation.

After full consideration of this application we are of the opinion that the authority sought by applicant is in the public interest and it will be granted. No public hearing appears to be necessary.

ORDER

It being hereby found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED that Orville C. Head is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon the passenger stage operation between Oxnard and Camarillo State Hospital and intermediate points heretofore authorized by Decision No. 35300, in Application No. 24793, and the operative right created by said decision is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Orville C. Head are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
