ORDER OF REVOCATION

On April 13, 1944, the Commission received from Jane O. Panopulos, Executrix of the estate of Gregory G. Panopulos, deceased, a statement in writing that all highway common carrier operations under certificates of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said Gregory G. Panopulos, deceased, were discontinued and abandoned prior to January 1, 1944; that all automotive equipment of the estate of said Gregory G. Panopulos, deceased, has been disposed of, and requesting the Railroad Commission to revoke all operative rights standing in the name of said Gregory G. Panopulos, deceased.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Gregory G. Panopulos by the Commission's Decision No. 28186, dated August 26, 1935, as amended by Decision No. 28339, dated November 12, 1935, in Application No. 19951, is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective

tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of said Gregory G. Panopulos are hereby cancelled.
