O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company has filed application to abandon its non-agency station of Paola, Modoc County. Said station is located within the limits of its Alturas Yard and has in the past been used principally for the shipping of live stock. Existing facilities will be retained but operated as a portion of the Alturas station facilities. No abandonment of facilities is proposed. As the tariffs applying at Paola are identical with those at Alturas no increase in rates is involved. The abandonment consists simply of discontinuance of the use of the name Paola and the publishing of tariffs for that point. The California Farm Bureau Federation and California Cattlemen's Association have signified in writing that they have no objection to the proposed change.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Paola, County of Modoc; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not

exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
