BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of 47th Street in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application. Said street is not traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing a crossing with said track. Copy of permit from the City of Richmond is attached to the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
