SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By prior orders (Decision No. 31930 of April 18, 1939, as amended) in this proceeding, applicant has been authorized to transport pulpboard, in minimum quantities of 30,000 pounds, for Fibre-board Products, Inc. from Vernon to Southgate at a rate of 3 cents per 100 pounds. The minimum rate otherwise applicable to such transportation, prescribed by Decision No. 32504 (42 C.R.C. 239), as amended, is 6½ cents per 100 pounds. The authority to observe the 3-cent rate expires May 18, 1944. Its indefinite extension is now sought.

The verified supplemental application discloses that there has been no substantial change in the unusually favorable conditions surrounding performance of the service in question. It also discloses that, under these conditions, operations under the 3-cent rate have been fully compensatory.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that a one-year extension of applicant's authority is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 31930 of April 18, 1939, as amended, in the above entitled application be and it is hereby extended to May 18, 1945, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective May 18, 1944.
