FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 32896, rendered March 12, 1940, in the above-entitled matters, the Commission authorized the Humboldt Motor Stages, Inc. to lease from Leslie T. Alward certain passenger stage operative rights and equipment as more particularly defined in such decision. The lease agreement provided for the payment of a rental of \$125 a month for a term of four years, and upon completion of the lease agreement title would be conveyed to the lessee.

In the supplemental application now filed it is recited that all sums required to be paid under the lease have been paid by Aumboldt Motor Stages, Inc. and that Myrtle R. Alward, administratrix of the estate of Leslie T. Alward, deceased, will convey the properties. The Commission is now requested to authorize the transfer of the operative rights and ecuipment involved. Good cause appearing,
