BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 30107, rendered September 17, 1937, the Commission granted a certificate to Napa Transportation Company, a corporation, predecessor in interest to Kellogg Express and Draying Co., applicant herein, authorizing the operation of a highway common carrier service on alternate days between San Francisco and Napa in coordination and conjunction with its vessel service between these points. On May 5, 1942, by Decision No. 35307, said Decision No. 30107 was amended to permit the operation "as traffic requirements demand," rather than on alternate days, for a period of one year from the effective date thereof unless extended by further order of the Commission. Said Decision No. 35307 also authorized highway common carrier service between Napa and Vallejo to be coordinated with its vessel service for less-than-carload traffic limited to a period of one year unless extended by further order of the Commission.

By Decision No. 36358, rendered May 18, 1943, the foregoing described temporary authority was extended to and including May 5, 1944. Kellogg Express and Draying Co., by supplemental

application, requests that the authority granted in said Decision No. 35307 be further extended from May 5, 1944 to and including May 5, 1945. In support of this request applicant asserts that public convenience and necessity still require and will require the continued operation of the service provided for the extended time as requested.

This is not a matter requiring a public hearing and the authority sought will be granted.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that Kellogg Express and Draying Co., a corporation, is hereby authorized to continue the service heretofore granted by Decision No. 35307 to and including May 5, 1945, on which date it shall expire unless further extended by order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
