SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ORIGINAL

In its Seventy-first Supplemental Application Key System proposes to revise a portion of the route of its No. 80 Oakland-Castro Valley line, its No. 81 Oakland-San Lorenzo line and its No. 82 Oakland-Hayward line in order to eliminate the right-hand turning movements at 13th and Oak Streets and at 12th and Oak Streets by operating eastbound along 13th Street to 12th Street.

Applicant now operates the above lines outbound along 13th Street to Oak Street, along Oak Street to 12th Street, along 12th Street to 1st Avenue, 1st Avenue to East 14th Street. In the westbound direction, however, these lines are operated in the vicinity involved along East 12th Street to Fallon Street, along Fallon Street to 10th Street, and along 10th Street to Clay Street. No change is proposed in the westbound direction. In order to obviate the right-hand turning movements as heretofore mentioned, these lines would operate eastward along 13th Street to 12th Street, thence along 12th Street, and so forth.

It appears that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Key System is authorized to modify the eastbound route of its No. 80 Oakland-Castro Valley line, its

No. 81 Oakland-San Lorenzo line and its No. 82 Oakland-Hayward motor coach line along 13th Street between Oak and 14th Streets and to suspend the operations of these lines along Oak Street between 13th and 12th Streets and along 12th Street between Oak and Fallon Streets.

In all other respects decisions in Application No. 19502 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
