## MAIRD SUPPLEEENRAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35133, as amended, in this proceeding, appilcant was authorized to suspend public utility warehouse operations at Los Angeles Zarbor until July 1,1944 , because the property formenly used in these operations was taken by the United States for war use. Further suspension is now sought to July 1, 1945, and continuousiy thereaiter so long as the property in ouestion romains in the possession of the United States.

The verified appilcation shows that, by notice dated May 31, 1944, the United States has elected to extend the term of its possession of the property to June 30, 2945. Applicant represents, moreover, that there is no reason to believe that possession of the property wili be relinquished prior to the termination of the war.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hoaring is not necosssry and that further susponsion of applicant's operations is justified. Eowever, it has not been shown that suspension of scrvice beyond June 30 , 2945 , should be autionized at this time.

Therefore, good causo appearing,

IT IS FEREBY ORDERED that Western Compress Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to suspend public utility warehouse operations at Los Angeles Earbor until July 1,1945; and that said Wester Compress Company shall forthwith amend its tariff on file with the commission to show that operations have been furtive suspended as authorized herein.
