BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to abolish and physically close to public use the grade crossing at Bean Street in the City of San Diego (Crossing No.2-265.7 subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Effective barricades shall be erected on each side of the tracks to prevent public use.
- (2) Paving material between the rails at this crossing shall be removed.
- (3) All expense shall be borne by applicant.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
