ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By virtue of Decision No. 36592, D. Moyers holds a certificate from the Commission to conduct a passenger stage service between Clovis and Mt. Owens Range. In the above entitled application he requests authority to suspend the service temporarily, alleging as a reason the lack of sufficient patronage to continue operation due to the closing of the United States Army Air Corps camp at Mt. Owens Range.

Subsequent to filing said application Moyers was advised by the United States War Department that it has decided to continue to operate the camp at Mt. Owens, and that the service would be required. Accordingly, he has requested the Commission, in writing, to dismiss the application.

In view of the foregoing facts, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
