O P I N I O N

In this proceeding Earl C. Cook, doing business as Cook's Stages, sought a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation between Taft and Maricopa and intermediate points as an extension and enlargement of his present operation between Taft and Bakersfield and other points.

A public hearing thereon was had before Examiner Paul at Maricopa on July 28, 1944. Applicant introduced some evidence in support of his application. Before completion of his showing, applicant requested that the application be dismissed without prejudice. Such will be the order.
