O P I N I O N

In this proceeding applicant Robert G. Anderson, doing business as Marin-Sonoma Fast Freight, who operated as a highway common carrier between San Francisco and certain points in Marin and Sonoma Counties, sought a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing an extension of service to Sonoma and other points intermediate to San Rafael and Santa Rosa, via Sonoma, and also to the Naval Base at Seaggs Island, six miles southeast of Sonoma. A public hearing was had at Sonoma, but the matter was never submitted, it having been dropped from the calendar, at applicant's request, because of prevailing war conditions. Asserting that, under existing conditions, it does not seem appropriate to proceed further with the matter, applicant now seeks a dismissal, without prejudice to reopening the proceeding later, should he be so advised.

An order will be entered accordingly.

ORDER

Application having been made as above entitled; applicant having requested the dismissal of said proceeding; and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be, and it hereby is, dismissed; without prejudice, however, to the filing of a supplemental application herein by applicant for the reopening of said matter for further hearing, if applicant should be so advised; and to the reopening thereof for such further proceedings as may be deemed appropriate.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
