BY THE COMMISSION:

**ORIGINAL**O R D E R

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, are authorized to construct a side track at grade across Jurupa Avenue in Riverside, County of Riverside, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3-48.7-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
