SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its original Application No. 26054 Southern Pacific Company was authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Proberta in Tehama County. Applicant has now filed a supplemental application stating that certain business has developed at this point and it now desires a supplemental order authorizing reclassification of this station as a Class D station at which freight in lots not exceeding 5,000 lbs. will be received and forwarded.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reopen and reclassify its station at Proberta, Tehama County, as a Class D Station, to abandon and remove the platform and freight shed at said station, and to change its station records accordingly.

Within thirty days after putting into effect this change and the abandonment and removal of facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year from the date of this order, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
