ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

By order dated June 13, 1944, the Commission suspended until September 13, 1944, the operation of Rule No. 207 of National Perishable Freight Committee, Perishable Protective Tariff No. 13, Cal. R.C. No. 14, providing for the assessment of applicable refrigeration charges on each shipment transported in one car under the provisions of Rule No. 33 of Western Classification No. 71, C.R.C.-W.C. No. 4 of R.C. Fyfe, Agent. Thereafter the suspended rule was canceled by a schedule filed pursuant to special authorization obtained from the Commission. The cause for suspension having been removed, our order of June 13, 1944 will be vacated and the proceeding discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order of suspension and investigation in this proceeding be and it is hereby vacated and the proceeding discontinued.
