ORIGINAL THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35390, as amended, in this proceeding, C. J. Nagel, an individual doing business as Red Line Parcel Service, was authorized to perform retail parcel delivery service for certain retail stores located in San Jose at rates less than those established as minima. This authority expired May 19, 1944. A one-year l

The verified application shows that the volume of applicant's traffic has been materially reduced by curtailment of service pursuant to orders of the Office of Defense Transportation but that the net operating results under these changed conditions remained substantially the same. It also shows that the operation may still be performed on a compensatory basis at the rates previously authorized.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that applicant's authority should be reinstated.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that C. J. Nagel, an individual doing business as Red Line Parcel Service, be and he is hereby authorized to transport property in shipments weighing 25 pounds or less from the retail stores in San Jose named in Appendix "A" of Decision No.

As the authority has expired, the application for its extension will be considered as a request for reinstatement.
