OPINION AND ORDER ON PETITION FOR REHEARING

By the above application Western Warehouse and Transfer Company sought authority to discontinue a public utility warehouse business in Los Angeles. Deciding shortly thereafter to sell its operative right to J. S. Craig, Western applied for an order authorizing the transfer, which was granted by the Commission on June 8, 1943 (Decision No. 36417, Application No. 25648). On July 23, 1943, Western dismissed its application to discontinue service. The Commission, however, by Decision No. 36757, of December 7, 1943 (as amended by Decision No. 36762 of December 9, 1943) granted the application to abandon service, following a further hearing in the transfer proceeding, wherein the transfer authorization was ordered rescinded. (Decision No. 36756, 45 C.R.C. 87.) to abandon, however, did not become effective, it having been suspended by a petition for rehearing filed by Western and Craig on December 16, 1943. Upon consideration of the petition, the Commission is of the opinion that the application to discontinue service should be dismissed. A rehearing is not necessary.

⁽¹⁾ Petition for rehearing of Decision No. 36756, in Application No. 25648 was filed by Western and Craig on December 16, 1943. By a decision issued this day, the Commission vacated its rescission order and reinstated the transfer authorization contained in Decision No. 36417.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 36757 and its amending Decision No. 36762, be and each of them is hereby rescinded.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.

This order shall be effective as of the date hereof.
