ORDER

hereby authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Oak Avenue in the City of Torrance, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2H-7.2C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to standard No. 2 of G. O. 72, without superclevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with readway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. 75-B.).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.
