O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a side track at separated grades over county road (Dyer Road) near Altamont, Alameda County, at the location as shown by maps (Exhibits A and B) attached to the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-55.9-B. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Width of roadway shall be not less than twelve feet. In all other respects provisions of General Order No. 26-C shall be complied with.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
