BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct two wye tracks at grade across "H" Street and two wye tracks at grade across Trinity Street in Mojave, Kern County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

This order is made upon the express condition that "H" Street and Trinity Street are not now actually constructed and open to travel at the respective points of crossing and this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said streets to public use across said tracks. Said tracks shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding four per cent will be possible in the event that the construction of an opening of "H" Street or Trinity Street across said wye tracks shall hereafter be authorized and so that said grade crossings may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
