ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Everett Street in Alameda, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-10.13-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superclevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street new graded, with tops of rails flush with readway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), new in place.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be rovoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
