BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct a public highway at grade across the San Ramon Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Alamo, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 30-53.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than five per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. 75-B).

Upon completion, the private crossing located about ninety feet northerly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require.

The crossing herein authorized is to be constructed in lieu of the crossing authorized in Decision No. 37169 on Application No. 26203, and said Decision No. 37169 is hereby revoked and Application No. 26203 is dismissed.

This order shall be effective immediately.
