ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 36362, a certificate was granted to J. E. Miller authorizing a highway common carrier service between Torrance and points adjacent thereto in Los Angeles County and a portion of the city of Los Angeles. This certificate was limited to the rail traffic of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company.

Mr. Miller has informed the Commission in writing that he has abandoned the operation authorized by said Decision No. 36362 and requests the Commission to revoke the operative right. (1)

Therefore, good cause appearing,

(1) By Decision No. 37249, in Application No. 26158, the Commission granted to J. A. Clark Draying Company, Ltd., a corporation, a certificate authorizing a service identical to that formerly provided by Miller.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted by Decision No. 36362 is hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission, and in effect in the name of J. E. Miller, are hereby cancelled.
