BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct an interchange track at grade across Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Streets in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings No. 4-139.2-C; 4-139.15-C and 4-139.1-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach conforming as nearly as practicable with existing approach grades. Existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs may be rearranged if necessary. (G. O. No. 75-B)

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This Authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public

convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
