ORDER

**ORIGINAL**

Union Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct one passing track at grade across Otis Street in the City of Huntington Park, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 3A-6.6. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded with tops of rails flush with roadway and with a grade of approach not exceeding 8 per cent. Existing protection consisting of two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) will suffice at this time.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective

immediately.
